

KEEPING YOUR HARDWARE CLEAN

DO

TARGET

HIGH-TOUCH SURFACES with frequent hand contact



USE

NON-ABRASIVE ANTI-BACTERIAL SOAP AND WATER SOLUTION, using a soft cloth, gently wipe all surfaces



CLEAN

A SOFT CLOTH AND WATER ONLY, wipe remaining residue



ALLOW

THE TREATED SURFACE
TO AIRDRY



DONOT



DO NOT USE

HIGH CONCENTRATIONS OF BLEACH, OR HIGH ALKALINE CLEANERS (eg. ammonia) because it can damage the metals and plastics



DO NOT USE

CLEANSERS TYPICALLY USED FOR BATHROOM FIXTURES AND INDUSTRIAL SOLVENTS as they damage the protective finish



DO NOT USE

ABRASIVE PRODUCTS SUCH AS SCOURING PADS OR STEEL WOOL to avoid defacement



DO NOT

SPRAY DIRECTLY ONTO THE PRODUCT can damage the surface

+ TIPS

To best prevent germ-transmission, frequently clean and disinfect all door hardware. To prevent contact, leave interior doors open unless it poses a security risk.

Additionally, to avoid the spread of COVID-19, as recommended by the World Health Organization, wash your hands frequently, wear a protective face mask in public, and practice social distancing.
